


Our Approach

Reach believes that an inquiry and research-based approach to teaching is vitally important to high quality teaching. The program supports teachers to move from using habits of inquiry in addressing problems of practice to designing robust research questions, and consulting research and professional literature to expand their thinking about their practice. Teachers apply this new knowledge to a problem of practice, gather resultant data and analyze their findings.

Program Goals

Candidates who complete the Master's in Teaching & Induction Program earn a Master of Education in Teaching and a California Clear Teaching Credential while developing into skilled classroom leaders, with a mindset toward inquiry in education.

Who is eligible for the Master's in Teaching & Induction Program?

Candidate Qualifications

To be eligible, you must meet the following conditions:



Teachers who have completed our Teaching Academy's Intern Program, earning a Preliminary Credential (without TPA or RICA renewal codes) through Reach.

or



Teachers who have a preliminary California teaching credential from another accredited credentialing institution may be eligible upon completion of one year of TIP (teacher induction) and an additional course.

Teachers interested in this option should contact Reach as soon as possible for additional information.

or



Any teacher who has completed the regular Reach TIP (ECO excluded).

and



Teachers must have at least one class of students in their credential area.
